JAPANESE STUDIES SCHOLARSHIP**

(For studies at universities located in Western Australia's Sister-State, Hyogo Prefecture)

These scholarships aim to provide promising Western Australian students or graduates, who are proficient in the Japanese language, with the opportunity to spend up to one year studying at a university in Japan.

The scholarships include a return airfare, an initial payment of \$3,000 for fees and other expenses and a maintenance allowance of ¥200,000 per month.

### ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must be a Western Australian higher education student or graduate who has successfully completed at least two years of full time study (or equivalent part-time study) in an appropriate Japanese language course, by the end of this year.

Applicants should have Japanese language proficiency at a level that will enable them to effectively carry out a course of study at a university in Japan.

Applicants are required to apply for both scholarships.
